DESCRIPTION

Auld & White Constructors partnered with LS3P (formerly ENB) Architects to complete the 11,500 SF fire station which includes a four-bay apparatus garage, dispatch room, day room, kitchen and dining room, outdoor cover patio, bunk room for 10 fire & rescue personnel, a private bedroom and bathroom for the station chief, counseling/study room, fitness room, restrooms, lockers room, bunker gear room, laundry, multiple storage rooms, and miscellaneous support spaces including a janitor's closet, electrical room and mechanical rooms. Sharing the site with Fire Station #73 is the 911 Backup Call Center. The building is approximately 13,956 SF and includes a call center room with 48 workstations, offices for both the JFRD and JSO, multi-purpose room for training, quiet room, IT office, break room with outdoor covered patio, restrooms and showers, and various support spaces including a service room, janitor's closet, electrical room, and fire riser room.

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
