DESCRIPTION

Auld & White Constructors (AWC) was retained by the City of Jacksonville to complete a new Community Center in Mayport, FL. The two-story building was designed in pre-Civil War style architecture to pay tribute to the historical past of the fishing village. The project includes a two-tiered veranda with posts and rails, similar to the Gavagan Hotel and King's Residence (located blocks away). The top of the building features a decorative three-window wide cupola, adding a touch of classic charm to the structure.

The project replaced a smaller, outdated community center located in a trailer across the streeT. The new building boasts a large community room, multiple office spaces, a warming kitchen, table storage, an elevator, and several restrooms. It also provides overflow parking with easier maneuverability and turning radiuses, helping reduce congestion for the adjacent boat ramp.
